

## **MEDIA STATEMENT OF SRI ASHOK SINGHAL, INT'L PRESIDENT, VISHVA HINDU PARISHAD**

**New Delhi, August 27, 2010 –**

Media reports have been pouring in that after a wait of over 60 years the judgment on Sri Rama Janma Bhumi case would be delivered in September 2010. Its signs had become apparent to the Sants at the beginning of the year. The Sants take it that the final solution to the Sri Rama Janma Bhumi case would come through a Law of Parliament alone and that is why the High Power Committee of the Sants initiated a wide ranging programme in the form of “Sri Hanumat Shakti Jagaran” (invoking the Might of Sri Hanuman) for awakening the Hindus and other nationalists of Bharat and also overseas Hindus. The highlights of the 4-month long programme between August 16, 2010 and December 17, 2010 would be mobilization of crores of Hindus through collective recitals (Paaraayan) of Sri Hanuman Chalisa at lakhs of temples and other sacred places and passing of and signing on a Resolution calling for handing over of Sri Rama Janma Bhumi to the Hindu society through a Law of Parliament. The Sants also decided that the seriousness and sincerity of this sacred programme would not be compromised with irrespective of the outcome of the court judgment, because this programme would ensure handing over of Sri Rama Janma Bhumi to the Hindu society on the one hand and ensure peace and goodwill in the country on the other.

The Sant High Power Committee clearly resolved that this sacred movement under the leadership of Sants being a matter of faith and belief of over a billion Hindus that form 1/6th of the global population, no one must exploit it for earning votes. The Sant fraternity also urged all political parties to support this common national cause rising above party politics and bury their differences to unanimously enact a Parliamentary Law to handover the birthplace of Sri Ram at Ayodhya to the Hindu society. The Sant Samaj made it absolutely clear that to Hindus the birthplace of Sri Ram is not a ‘property’, but as much a “Deity” as Sri Ram Lala (Infant Sri Ram) and, therefore, worthy of worship in this capacity. Millions of devotees have since sacrificed their lives for the sake of this site. The temple marking the birthplace of Sri Rama will be built after the model - the picture of which is adored at millions of homes – and towards which cause crores of Hindus have each offered Rs. 1.25 (Rupee One & Paise twenty-five only). The temple will be built with the carved stone blocks kept safe and secure at the Ayodhya workshop which thousands of pilgrims have Darshan of daily. The Sant Samaj has declared that no mosque would be allowed to be built within the cultural range of Ayodhya and no mosque glorifying the barbaric foreign invader Babur would be allowed to be built anywhere in the whole country.

I appeal to all key personages of the country to extend their hearty cooperation to this sacred movement for reconstruction of Sri Rama Janma Bhumi Temple.
